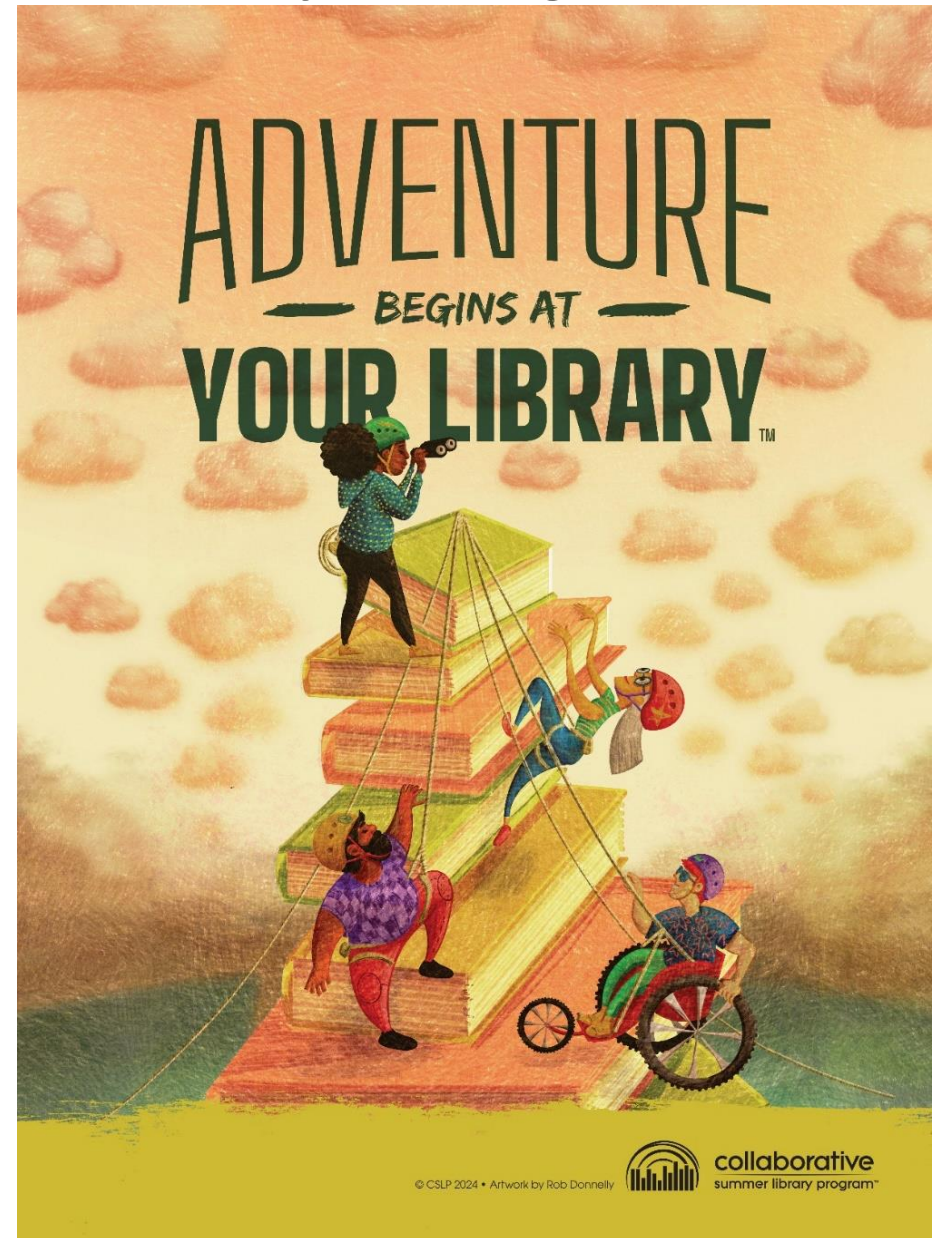

What is the Adult Summer Reading Program?

This is a program to encourage adults to read during the summer months (and throughout the year).

How does it work?

- Sign up for the Summer Reading Program at the library, by emailing cfpl_green@hotmail.com, or by calling the library at (603) 878-1105. Adult Summer Reading bingo cards can be picked up at the library at any time, or we can email one to you so you can print it from home.
- Complete one row of the Adult Summer Reading bingo card (left to right, top to bottom, or corner to corner) beginning on July 1st. Turn in your bingo card with at least one completed row by August 8th. For each bingo row you complete, you will get one entry into a raffle drawing for a \$50 Amazon gift card.
- Attend our programs.

What counts as reading?

Reading a print book or ebook, or listening to an audiobook.
