### Who can participate?



**SIGN UP** for the Summer Reading Program at the library, by emailing cfpl\_green@hotmail.com, or by calling the library at (603) 878-1105. Your child's reading log can be picked up at the library at any time, or we can email it to you so you can print it from home.
