How it Works

SIGN UP for the Summer Reading Program at the library, by emailing cfpl_green@hotmail.com, or by calling the library at (603) 878-1105. Your child's reading log can be picked up at the library at any time, or we can email it to you so you can print it from home.

READ! Complete the reading log and return it to the library (or email a picture of the completed log to cfpl_green@hotmail.com) by August 8th. Each child who turns in a completed reading log by August 8th will get to pick a small prize, receive a certificate, and have their name entered in a raffle for larger prizes. There will be one winner for each prize.

What counts as reading?

- Reading any print book or ebook yourself
- Reading aloud to family or friends
- Being read to
- Listening to an audiobook
